Hello and Happy Friday to everyone! We wanted to thank everyone for their support as we embark further into this journey advocating for the wild horses in Theodore Roosevelt National Park in Medora, ND. We want to assure you that even though we have been quiet here, we are working hard behind the scenes to be a voice for the wild horses that call TRNP home. We will have some information to share with you soon – WE PROMISE!

As you read this post, please know that we started this non-profit as a way to direct our energy toward advocating for the wild horses that call TRNP home. We have a non-profit lawyer that we check in with several times a month to make sure we are dotting our i's and crossing our t's. We want you to know that there is a clear separation between our "for profit" business and this non-profit.

Our for-profit business will help as much as they can to support our advocacy efforts. As with any non-profit, we will need help and support from all of you to see success in our advocacy work. We want you to know that all of our board members understand, and it is written in all of our non-profit paperwork, that NONE of our volunteers are paid. None of our volunteers are reimbursed for travel expenses. We

had clear discussions as a board on this. We all agreed to serve under those agreements. The simple reason is that we are NOT here to profit in any way and any reimbursements that would be made to board members would take away from our advocacy efforts and take away from the horses in TRNP. That would be counterproductive to the reasons why this non-profit group was started.

We also want to thank all of you who consistently let us know that the non-profit group, North Dakota Badlands Horse, along with their board members and supporters are constantly bad mouthing us and spreading lies about myself, my husband and our for-profit business. Marylu Weber, President of North Dakota Badlands Horse, consistently states that she wishes that we could all just work together. We decided to take her up on her words and extended an olive branch to her. We offered to maintain our respect for her and her organization, understanding that we may not agree on all points, but we were simply asking that we find a way to RESPECTFULLY agree to disagree so that both of our organizations can continue to focus on helping the wild horses in TRNP. We are hoping that she will take us up on this offer so that we can quit wasting so much time speaking with state and local law enforcement and attorneys. They have been alerted to our valid concerns that the lies and slander being spread by NDBH and their supporters may lead to physical violence. After several board meetings to discuss this matter, we have yet to hear back from Marylu or see any proof that she is willing to act on the words she uses so often about wanting everyone getting along.

We sincerely hope that the pettiness can stop but also understand that we cannot control the hateful actions of others, especially when they are being cheered on by the president of a non-profit organization.

We will keep you posted on any developments.
